Our annual Bike-a-thon fundraiser is just around the corner!

Background: The Bike-a-thon is an annual event, and our first fundraiser for the year. This is a really fun event for all the children and families, and everyone is welcome to attend the day. The children complete laps of the bike track, according to their year groups in a set time period which is appropriate for their age. Children are welcome to bring their own bikes and helmets on the day, and we do have a limited number of bikes at school to use. For children who might find it a bit of a struggle on the bike track (training wheels or would like to use scooters), a loop will be made on the round-about and court.

The funds raised from this event will continue to go towards upgrading our playgrounds, playing surfaces, and other items that we have on our fundraising wish list.
